

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE WINE PRAGUE 2026 TRADE FAIR

Organizer: YACHT, s.r.o., Nedvědovo náměstí 14, 147 00 Prague 4, VAT ID: CZ25062701, Czech Republic

Exhibitor: A legal entity or natural person whose participation in the trade fair has been confirmed by YACHT, s.r.o.

Venue: Palác Žofín, Slovanský ostrov, Prague 1

Conditions of Participation

The basic condition for participation in the trade fair is the submission of a duly completed Binding Application for Company Participation in the Trade Fair. Upon receipt, YACHT, s.r.o. (hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer") will send the exhibitor a confirmation of its acceptance.

By submitting the Binding Application, the exhibitor agrees to comply with the Terms and Conditions for Exhibitor Participation in the Trade Fair.

After receiving the Binding Application, the Organizer will issue a proforma invoice. Upon its payment, the exhibition space (table) will be reserved. Applications will be processed in the order in which they are received, depending on timely payment of the required deposit and the availability of tables. Subletting or participation of third parties is not permitted.

The capacity of the exhibition premises is limited. Once the capacity has been reached, the Organizer reserves the right to refuse additional exhibitors.

Exhibited items and offered services must correspond to the focus of the trade fair (i.e. the sector classification of the fair).

The final invoice, deducting the paid deposits, will be issued after the end of the trade fair.

Cancellation of Participation

If the exhibitor cancels participation in the trade fair, the following cancellation fees (contractual penalties) shall apply:

- 50% of the total amount if the Binding Application is cancelled up to 90 days before the opening of the trade fair
- 100% of the total amount if the Binding Application is cancelled up to 30 days before the opening of the trade fair

Exhibition Space

The layout plan of the exhibition areas, including the assigned location, will be provided to the exhibitor after all due payments have been settled and after final processing of the Binding Applications.

The exhibitor is obliged to leave the exhibition space in the condition in which it was prior to the start of the exhibition. Any destruction, damage, or excessive soiling must be compensated by the exhibitor according to the actual costs incurred in remedying the damage (cleaning).

Exhibitors are required to comply with the designated arrival and departure times for the exhibition premises.

Liability and Insurance

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to exhibits or other property belonging to the exhibitor. All types of insurance must be arranged by the exhibitor individually. The exhibitor is liable for any damage caused by them or by persons associated with them.

Obligations of the Exhibitor

Participants will receive an exhibitor pass, which must be worn visibly and is non-transferable. Forgery, copying, or duplication of the exhibitor pass is strictly prohibited.

Catering services at Palác Žofín are exclusively provided by STONES catering s.r.o.

Connecting personal electrical appliances to the venue's power supply is prohibited at Palác Žofín.

Smoking is prohibited throughout the entire Palác Žofín building.

Animals are not permitted at the venue.

Exhibitor Presentation

The exhibitor is entitled to promote their products or services only within their own exhibition stand and must not disturb or restrict neighboring stands.

Placement of any advertising or promotional materials outside the exhibitor's own stand is permitted only after prior agreement with the Organizer and for a fee not included in the exhibition space rental price.

The Organizer is entitled to prohibit or remove, at the exhibitor's expense, any advertising that does not comply with the above conditions.

Filming and Photography

The Organizer has the right to photograph and film at the exhibition premises for its own purposes or for general publications. In this regard, the exhibitor waives any claims arising from copyright law.

Force Majeure and Significant Factors

If the trade fair cannot be held due to force majeure, strikes, political unrest, official regulations, or other reasons beyond the Organizer's control that prevent the event from taking place, the Organizer shall inform the exhibitor without delay. In such case, the exhibitor's costs will be reimbursed.

However, the Organizer is entitled to retain 25% of the rental price as a flat-rate compensation for costs and expenses, or to deduct this amount from any payment already made by the exhibitor. This serves to partially cover the substantial initial costs incurred by the Organizer.

These Terms and Conditions form an integral part of the Binding Application for Company Participation in the WINE PRAGUE trade fair.
